

## Science

As part of our topic you will be learning how to classify plants and animals. You will also be carrying out an experiment involving growing bacteria.

## Music

You will be listening to a range of traditional Welsh music. You will then need to critique the music before composing your own.

## Art and Design

You will learning how to use watercolours to create a landscape scene of Arthog.
