

Covid Catch Up Premium 2020-2021

This is funding provided by the Government to help support pupils to catch up for lost teaching during the coronavirus pandemic. It should be used to fund specific activities, which will help pupils catch up on missed education.

Our model for spending the premium is based on the 'Education Endowment Foundation' recommendations for a tiered approach to support school improvement 2020-2021.

- 1. Teaching: high quality teaching for all; effective diagnostic assessment; supporting remote learning; focussing on professional development.
- 2. Targeted academic support: high quality one to one or small group tuition; teaching assistants and targeted support; academic tutoring; planning for pupils with SENDs.
- 3. Wider school strategies: Supporting pupils' social, emotional and behavioural needs; planning carefully for adopting a SEL curriculum; communicating with and supporting parents; successful implementation in challenging times.
